



ROADS AND FLORIDA PANTHERS

The Florida panther is an isolated population of America's large cat that is also known as a puma, cougar, or mountain lion. As the panther population increases, vehicular collisions are one of the leading causes of death - and a growing threat for many other Florida animals.

60 SECONDS FOR YOU. A LIFETIME FOR A CAT.

Panther activity is greatest between dusk and dawn when visibility is lowest. Nighttime speed zones exist where panthers are known to frequently cross roads. At the posted 45 mph speed, driving through a 3-mile-long panther zone only takes an extra minute compared to traveling at 60 mph. Driving at this rate gives you more time to react - and save a life.

GOOD FOR PANTHERS - AND YOUR WALLET

The average cost of a speeding ticket issued in a nighttime panther speed zone often exceeds \$200 and excessive speeds require a mandatory court appearance. By obeying the posted speeds you can also help our state's panthers and reduce your risk of personal injury and property damage.
